

## MAMBA Amendment Reasoning

- 1- I move to amend 'Mission Statement' by striking out 'mountain bike'.
  - a. Reason: This will simplify the mission statement to be more inclusive of the forms of recreation that use the trails.
- 2- I move to amend 'Mission Statement' by striking out 'A fundamental component of MAMBA's mission is respect for private land and the desires of the private landowners that allow us to recreate on their lands'
  - a. Reason: This will simplify the mission statement and also be more inclusive of the public lands that MAMBA currently works with.
- 3- I move to amend 'Mission Statement' by striking out 'our'.
  - a. Reason: This will simplify the mission statement.
- 4- I move to amend Article A, Section A.2, by striking out 'position' and inserting 'officer' in the first paragraph.
  - a. Reason: This will reduce confusion of who needs to be elected every year. Only the officers, not the entire board, needs to be elected.
- 5- I move to amend Article A, Section A.2, by inserting 'officer' in the second paragraph.
  - a. Reason: This clarifies what types of positions board members cannot hold two of. Board members can simultaneously hold a board officer position and an advisory position.
- 6- I move to amend Article A, Section A.2., by striking out 'be able to physically' in the second paragraph.
  - a. Reason: To allow meetings via zoom or other methods.
- 7- I move to amend Article A, Section A.2., by striking out 'either one, two or' in the second paragraph.
  - a. Reason: To clarify how long a board member term length is upon appointment.
- 8- I move to amend Article A, Section A.2, by striking out 'with not more than two positions changing in any one calendar year'
  - a. Reason: This wording could limit how many people can be on the board.
- 9- I move to amend Article A, Section A.2, by striking out 'active member' and inserting 'interested persons'
  - a. Reason: This would open up application to the board to anyone who is interested.
- 10- I move to amend Article A, Section A.2.a, by adding at the end 'Delegation of duties are allowed with board approval.'
  - a. Reason: At the moment the president does not explicitly have the power to delegate duties to others.
- 11- I move to amend Article A, Section A.2.b, by adding at the end 'Delegation of duties are allowed with board approval.'
  - a. Reason: At the moment the secretary does not explicitly have the power to delegate duties to others.
- 12- I move to amend Article A, Section A.2.c, by adding at the end 'Delegation of duties are allowed with board approval.'
  - a. Reason: At the moment the treasurer does not explicitly have the power to delegate duties to others.

- 13- I move to amend Article A, Section A.3, by striking out sections A.3.a-A.3.d.
- a. Reason: removing the in-depth descriptions of the trails chairperson, the director of communications, the immediate past president, and the landowner liaison allows for more flexibility in changing the job duties of those positions through a simple vote at a board meeting instead of a bylaws change. These four will still be advisory positions that exist and can be eliminated through a two-thirds vote of the board.
  - b. By striking these the following items must be addressed elsewhere:
    - i. Proposed changes to trails by approval of the board
- 14- I move to amend Article B, Section B.3, by striking out 'will' and inserting 'may'.
- a. Reason: Allows flexibility in the format of the meeting so we do not have to use Robert's Rules of Order if we do not want to.
- 15- I move to amend Article B, Section B.3, by striking out 'and members are encourage to attend.'
- a. Reason: This allows the board to hold 'board only meetings' where sensitive information is discussed and should be kept confidential.
- 16- I move to amend Article B, Section B.3, by inserting 'non-board'.
- a. Reason: This clarifies what type of 'member' is being referenced in this sentence.
- 17- I move to amend Article B, Section B.3, by inserting 'A director planned meeting can be called without consent from president but must be approved by 1/2 plus 1 of directors with 2 days notice to all board directors.'
- a. Reason: This allows for a board meeting to be called without the president. This also makes the next line with 'presiding individual' make more sense if that person is not the president.
- 18- I move to amend Article B, Section B.4, by inserting 'voting' before 'meetings of the board'.
- a. Reason: clarifies that the board can meet informally to talk about subjects that do not need a meeting where voting happens.
- 19- I move to amend Article B, Section B.4, by inserting 'club' before 'membership requires'.
- a. Reason: clarifies which type of meeting (board vs membership)
- 20- I move to amend Article D by striking out 'members' and inserting 'individuals' in the last sentence
- a. Reason: allows anyone to raise money for MAMBA.
- 21- I move to amend Article D by inserting 'from' between the words 'club' and 'businesses' in the first sentence.
- a. Reason: this was a typo in the original bylaws. It makes way more sense with the word 'from'.
